Live music

You can look forward to a great and exciting stage program! We will have enchanting multi-voiced singing, ElectroWavePunk, and rock music. In addition, there will be dance, choir, and cabaret performances—and perhaps one or two surprises!

Ase Crew – a combination of reggae, rap, jazz, and soul music that excites in Macedonian language.

Cementa – ElectroWavePunk from Cologne. Here, electro flows from the fingers and punk from the heart come together in wavy songs.

Pro C dur Choir – a cheerful and sociable a-cappella choir; versatile in its selection of songs from around the world. Soprano, alto, tenor, and bass provide the right mix, sound, and feeling.

Riosentí is a nomadic music project with Latin American roots that lovingly transcends geographical and cultural borders.

The fusion of Microphone Mafia and Buntes Herz, called **Bunta**, stands for the power of music, attitude, and social engagement.

Again and again, initiatives and associations will present short speeches or interviews on stage and give you the opportunity to get to know their work.
