„Syrian Revolution as a story of emancipation“

Presentation and talk
with Mariana Karkoulty and „Adopt a Revolution“
Thursday, 08.11.2018, Allerweltshaus, 19 pm



According to the European way of reporting, women appear mainly as victims of Dschadism. The activism and resistance of many Syrian women remains unseen. Mariana Karkoulty and „adopt a revolution“ will show us through their presentation that women take an important part in the resistance. The lawyer from Damascus will depict how women are discriminated against, particularly by discriminating laws. At the same time she will highlight how Syrian women get active and put up resistance against the daily discrimination

and exclusion. Moving on, the presentation focuses on the revolution as a "wind and hope of change" that Syrian women have intended to establish on both the political and the social level, giving some experiences and shedding the light on Syrian women's activism inside and outside Syria since the revolution started. In the end, the brutality of the regime is presented and its abuse of power by looking into methods that the regime uses to use women as "weapons of war".

„Adopt a Revolution“ was founded 2011 by Syrian and German activists as an independent non-profit organization. The organization supports projects working on civil society and independent reporting in Syria. At the same time they give the activism of Syrian a voice and a face, to make Syrian's activism in and out of Syria visible.
